- *Sunday, November 20. Join us at the "Table of the King" as we celebrate our blessings with a catered brunch following our worship service. Estimate of giving cards will be received during the offering. All members are welcome to attend as we celebrate Commitment Sunday.

When our hearts are open, God can cause great and wonderful things to happen. We fervently hope, pray, and believe that God will use this time to help us to continue to grow in our stewardship. We look forward to sharing in this joyful and powerful time – a time of celebration as we thank God for all that He is doing among us and through us!



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Interim Reflection

The Council has decided to direct the Nominating Committee to put together a slate of candidates for a Call Committee. The names will be placed in nomination at the Congregational meeting the end of January 2017.

This is just the first step in the call process. After the Call Committee is elected they will meet with our Montana Synod Bishop, Jessica Crist, or the Associate to the Bishop. This initial meeting will provide the Call Committee with directions to carry out their task.

The very first step will be to complete the Congregation's "Ministry Site Profile" (MSP). This document describes the congregation and its preferences pertaining to the new pastor. It is shared with those who are interested in the call to Pella.

The next step involves gathering names of potential candidates for the position of Pastor here at Pella. Names can be submitted by congregational members and the Bishop. (The position will be posted on the ELCA website for interested candidates to view.)

All those individuals will be contacted to ascertain their willingness to consider a call to Pella. A list of those who are open to considering Pella will be given to the Call Committee.

The Call Committee's focus at that point will be to narrow the choice to one recommendation for the Congregation to consider for the call. This will involve going over the candidate's profiles, checking references, and interviews. If no candidates are deemed to be an appropriate fit then further time will be taken for others to be identified and the Call Committee to bring forth a recommendation following another discernment process.

Finally, after a strong affirmative vote by the Congregation to extend a call, the pastor will have time to confirm the decision and agree to accept the call. The actual arrival of a new pastor will vary depending on their current call and circumstances.

The conclusion of the call process in total **could** take 9 - 18 months. With this in mind I would remind you to be patient and positive! You want the best match possible even if it takes some time for it to happen.

In the meantime I will be here. I have a great appreciation for you as a congregation – your ongoing ministry, your staff, your facility, and for the potential and power of the gospel you share in this community and the world. I am sure there is a capable and compatible pastor who will be delighted to receive and fulfill the call to ministry at and with Pella.

Pella Pantry Year End Report

The Pella Pantry Committee met on Sunday, October 9 to review the Pella Pantry outcomes for this past year. We were excited to see that we had a little more money to give away than we had anticipated! Our new pie cupboards were paid for with reserve funds set aside for Pella Pantry repairs/improvements, so we knew we needed to replenish those funds.

With that in mind, our net profit for this year's fair was \$9,686.98. We asked for Council approval to disperse as follows:

Council News Summary

The meeting was held on October 11, 2016. Financial reports were given by John. The checking account balance is \$92,000.32 and the general fund is \$8,101.67. Pastor Joel gave his report of activities throughout the month and upcoming events.

Erin Anderson reported for the Christian Education committee. All grade levels of WBS are fully staffed with teachers and the nursery is being well used. Third graders will receive their Bibles on October 9, and the WBS students will do special music that day. The Christmas program is scheduled for Wednesday, December 14, at 5:30 p.m. Erin also discussed the schedule for the rest of the school year and some conversation arising from non-member youth attending Confirmation. VBS dates have been set for June 19-23, 2017.

Randy Iversen reported for the Endowment committee. There has been a recommendation to separate the Endowment fund from the church accounts in order to keep it more secure. More research will be done on this process.

Diane Savage reported that Pastor Joel has been taking care of the visitation needs. April Boehler stated that the Church Directory is on schedule to be completed soon.

Randy Iversen reported that Pella Pantry made \$9,686.90 from the fair this year. The dispersements of those funds were approved. A list can be found on page 8 of this newsletter.

Diane Savage reported for the Personnel committee stating that Becky Reidle has transitioned into the Parish Assistant position. The church is still searching for an assistant custodian, and staff evaluations will be completed in October.

Mark Olson reported for Property and Grounds stating the tree removal at the north parsonage was successful, and the last big project is the outdoor sign.

Pastor reported that the Stewardship committee is getting things ready for this year's emphasis under the theme "Setting the Table of Grace."

April Boehler reported for the Worship and Music committee stating that all the copyright licenses must be renewed each year and there is funding available. Upcoming special services were discussed. An Advent message will be worked into the regular Sunday service or during fellowship afterwards. Christmas Eve services will be 3:30, 5:30 and 11 p.m., and the Christmas Day service on Sunday will be at 9 a.m.

Old Business: The Council voted and passed the Assistance and Safety guidelines, the janitorial assistant position was discussed, Constitution Task Force has four members and a meeting will be set up. Clarification regarding the purchase policy from February 10, 2016 was discussed and this requirement will be kept as is.

New Business: The Council voted to place some additional funding into the Discretionary fund. Facility requests were approved. The Council agreed to activate the Nominating Committee and being the process of creating a Call Committee. The Pastor's plan for a year of Table Talks was approved by the Council.
