

# God's Heroes Ascend on Pella to Strengthen Their Powers

Pella ministered to more than 60 kids during Vacation Bible School the third week of June (19-23). The kids were instantly clothed in their capes and re-named HEROES. From 2-5 p.m. each day heroes from preschool thru 5th grade gathered for a large-group opening. During openings, heroes learned about the message for the day from Captain Shield and Sidekick Flame, as well as from the Supersonic Shuttle that transmitted a daily mission to Pella's Dematerializer. Heroes also learned music and moves. After opening, heroes traveled to various stations: Bible, Science, Games, Snacks, and Crafts. Each day ended with a closing, with another visit from Captain Shield, Flame, and the Supersonic Shuttle crew.

#### **New Lay Pastoral Associate Class in Eastern Montana!**

A new Lay Pastoral Associate class, LPA East, has been proposed out of a strong need in this part of the Synod. Beginning October 2017, this new class will open up opportunities for those living in eastern Montana. This class will meet in Glendive at Zion Lutheran and be administered by the Montana Synod and hosted by Pastor Katie Emery. We are now looking for individuals interested in attending to speak with your pastor about the program. The first step in applying is to have your pastor (Pastor Joel) write a recommendation.

What is an LPA? A Lay Pastoral Associate in the Montana Synod is a congregational lay person who has received religious, educational training, through the Montana Synod, in order to provide (in most cases) short term pulpit supply (i.e., preaching) when the pastor is away, or if a congregation is without a pastor. Their role is to fill in for the basic pastoral duties such as providing Word and Sacrament, communion, and other roles as approved by the Bishop. LPAs are NOT authorized to preside at weddings. The program includes foundation courses in Old and New Testament, Church History and Lutheran Theology, retreats in the areas of Spirituality and Prayer, Worship leadership, Preaching and Pastoral Care, and Mentor guided activities. #### **Pastor Joel adds:**

Does Pella need any LPAs? Pella has utilized LPAs to preach and preside at worship at times when the pastor is away. I have also had LPAs lead and preach at mid-week Lenten worship. They could certainly help provide Children's sermons. Some become worship assistants who lead the prayers and other parts of the liturgy. Some LPAs choose not to preach or do other official tasks, instead they simply use their expanded knowledge and personal growth to inform and impact their faith and living in Christ and the mission of the congregation. I believe the LPA program enriches and strengthens the whole church.

I would be glad to receive inquiries and interest in this program. The cost is minimal, and now the location of classes will be much more accessible. I hope there will be some of you that will seriously consider this opportunity for growth and service.

# **Summary of Pella Council: June 2017**

A presentation was given by Thrivent representatives regarding Thrivent Choice Dollars and Thrivent Action Teams and how they can be used to benefit nonprofit entities such as Pella.

Call Committee member Bill Iversen brought the recommendation to the council that a special congregational meeting be called to vote on extending a call to Rev. Eric Olsen.

Reports were given by the Reformation 500 Task Force, Worship & Music, Christian Education, and Outreach committees.

Under Old Business the Pella Lutheran Church handbook was reviewed. Areas of modifications not previously addressed were discussed and recommendations made. The Council approved the handbook with the changes.

It was also reported that Pella's draft revised constitution is being reviewed with recommended conforming changes.

The Council objectives/goals for 2017 were reviewed and recognized as progressing.

Next meeting of Council will be Tuesday, July 11.
