Interim Perspective

Continue or start praying for Pella's Call process. The Call Committee is set to receive and consider names – pray for the Call Committee and their task of discernment. Pray for the potential candidates (pastors) to pay attention to the Spirit's leading. Pray for yourself and the other members and participants of Pella Lutheran that all will be ready to welcome and partner with a new pastor. Pray for the whole congregation that you and others will be ready for that transition and change.

Be kind to the Call Committee members. Remember they cannot share names and information about candidates unless the candidates agree. Some candidates are serving in calls and have not yet informed the congregation that they are seeking another call. Plus, not all information available to the Call Committee is for public distribution.

The process takes time. Be patient. The Call Committee will update us on an ongoing basis.

Consider attending the Montana Synod Assembly in Great Falls, June 2-4. The Council is looking for two volunteers (1 male, 1 female) to be Voting Members. Registration and hotel cost will be covered. You will experience and learn how the church is doing ministry and mission in Montana, in the rest of the ELCA and around the globe. Council Meeting Summary for April 11, 2017

- * A letter received by the Museum of Danish America was shared. It was noted that Pella would keep any Danish items at the church, but that perhaps an article could be written for the Ambassador.
- * Giving Statement from the MT Synod was read thanking Pella for its ministry and financial support.
- * The Checking Account has a balance of \$66,265 and the General Fund balance is \$1,957.87. The "Set Free to Serve" loan balance is currently at \$701,526. Council will pursue the possibility of loan refinancing.
- * \$1,430 had been collected for Montana Synod House.
- * Approval was voiced for receiving the following new members: Linda Weidrich; Yin Yu; Tyler Harris; and Josh, Britany, Rye, and Riggen Thrams.
- * Approval was also given for the following list for the Rite of Confirmation: Jaylen Baxter, Claire Frank, Jaxson Franklin, Kolby Hutzenbiler, Alexa Iversen, Braden Klinke, Liliana Johnson, Logan Jones, Ian Jurgens, Alexia Metz, Brodey Skogen, and Taylor Stewart.
- * No one has volunteered yet to be voting members at the Montana Synod Assembly (June 2-4 in Great Falls).
- * Janelle Lamb has volunteered to serve on the Reformation 500 Task Force.
- * Council approved the following for another term on the Endowment Committee: J. Harry Johnson, David McMillen, and Tina Montgomery.
- * Proposed changes to the Congregation's Constitution were handed out for review.
- * Council Objectives/Goals for 2017 were discussed.
- * The main goals of the Membership and Outreach Committee will be to define active membership, ways to increase membership, and overall outreach activities. Council members were asked to bring three names as suggestions for this committee.

Hej, Pella Medlemmer!

We recently received a letter from the Museum of Danish America. As Pella Church has its roots in the Danish community, the Pella Council thought this information may be of interest to some of our members.

First, the Danish American Archive and Library in Blair, Nebraska, and the Museum of Danish America in Elk Horn, Iowa, are both institutions interested in preserving archival materials and artifacts that tell the story of Danish immigration. If you have any Danish artifacts or archival materials in Danish that you no longer wish to keep or are looking for a place to preserve them, please contact either institution.

Secondly, the 125th anniversary of the Oaks Indian Mission is during 2017. In 1892, a Danish immigrant named Niels Laurids Nielsen went to live among the Cherokee in Indian Territory (what is now Oklahoma). His mission was to teach and preach to the Cherokee people. His mission was supported by congregations in Nebraska, Iowa, Minnesota, Wisconsin, and Illinois. With the passage of the Curtis Act in 1898, Nielsen's mission became much more important. In 1902, the UDELC (United Danish Evangelical Lutheran Church) approved the move of Nielsen to the Oaks mission and congregations of the UDELC across the country supported the Oaks Indian Mission. Older members of Pella's congregation may remember activities in support of this mission, whether through Sunday School, Ladies Aid, or the church budget. We will place an article about the Oaks Indian Mission on the bulletin board outside the office for those interested in reading more about Nielsen's work.

A celebration of the Danish-Lutheran presence among the Cherokee will be held on June 17-18 in Oaks, Oklahoma, to commemorate the 125th anniversary of the Oaks Indian Mission. All are invited to attend, but they would especially like members of congregations who supported the Oaks Indian Mission to attend. For more information about the celebration, places to stay, where to eat and the like, here is the contact information johnmark.nielsen@danishmuseum.org.
