## Minutes from Worship & Music August 20, 2017

The summer songfest had 19 people show up and the hour plus of constant singing went very fast. Was enjoyed by all there. It was suggested we plan further ahead next time. A joint worship service with St Matthew will be held the evening of Oct 22 at St. Matthews.

Violet received word that the three pianos were tuned by Chris Bengochea on Aug 5. Discussion was held and it was decided that the pianos are to be tuned by ONLY a Montana Certified Tuner—and Chris is the only one certified. He is also a technician, so he can do other adjustments as needed on the pianos. We would like the pianos checked out every 6 months, or according to Chris's schedule. In the past Violet was notified when Chris was coming. The grand has been kept "watered" quite well, and this was a task the office had said in the past that they would keep an eye on.

Natalie commented that she had listened to a radio broadcast in which the reader did not read the responses of the psalm, and she could not hear the congregation. We recommend the readers read ALL the psalm, and can read the responses a little softer that the rest.

It was suggested that the accompanist drop out an entire verse if the song is a familiar one.
